Inspection of Mount Hope Bridge to continue November 13-15

Residents are advised to expect delays

The Rhode Island Turnpike and Bridge Authority announced that the inspection of the Mount Hope Bridge will continue November 13-15.

"We understand that the ongoing bridge inspection will lead to additional delays, and we apologize for any inconvenience this may cause," said Lori Caron Silveira, Executive Director of the Rhode Island Turnpike and Bridge Authority. "The inspection is thorough, and it is essential to ensure the safety of the bridge. We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we complete this necessary work."

The inspection will take place daily from 9 am to 3 pm during this period. To accommodate the work, one lane will be closed, and traffic will alternate. Residents are advised to allow extra time for travel to account for potential delays.
